Program Description:	Lunch Bunch is a small group program. It is a time for sharing conversation and enjoying lunch with teachers and friends. A period of free play follows lunch. Younger Class and Older Class students share Lunch Bunch together.	Extended Learning is a small group program. The program is structured around a topic investigation or project. The project-based “inquiry” curriculum model focuses on topics in art, literature, nature, and science. The daily format includes lunch and a rest period.

LUNCH BUNCH PROGRAM DESCRIPTION AND APPLICATION
2011-2012

LUNCH BUNCH offers students in our Younger and Older Classes an opportunity to enjoy lunch at school following the morning classes. **LUNCH BUNCH** is an unstructured, extended playtime with friends and teachers. There are 12 openings for each day (Tuesday and Friday).

TIME & COST

Students go directly to Lunch Bunch at the end of the regular school session at 11:15 and stay until 12:45. The cost is \$19 per day.

- Lunch Bunch slots are purchased on an annual basis. Payments are due quarterly and are included on tuition payment vouchers for the year. A deposit equal to the 1st quarter payment will be due by May 13, 2011. This deposit will secure your child's spot for the 2011-2012 school year. Deposits are non-refundable.
- If a parent chooses to withdraw his/her child from the program, the parent is still responsible for the remaining yearly payment (until the Lunch Bunch coordinator is able to fill the slot).

FOOD ALLERGIES

Some students have food allergies that must be monitored both at snack time and lunch. It is our intention to make all reasonable accommodations (without imposing undue hardship on other enrolled students) to insure minimal risk of contamination by known allergens.

Parents of students with diagnosed/suspected food allergies are required to conference with the teachers before the opening of Lunch Bunch to discuss strategies for reducing risk and developing a food allergy action plan. Final placement in Lunch Bunch is subject to approval by L.L.L. staff and is determined on a case-by-case basis, following parent/teacher consultation.

LOTTERY

Lunch Bunch slots are filled by lottery, giving all children a chance to participate in the program. Please complete the application and return it to the Director, Linda Torrisi, **by MARCH 11, 2011**. Notification of enrollment will be done via email during the week of March 14th.

Lottery Process

A "three tiered" approach will be used for the 2011-2012 Lunch Bunch lottery. The purpose is to give each child the opportunity to attend Lunch Bunch for a minimum of 1 day each week. You may request more than one day, if you choose, but a lottery will held as followed:

- 1) All applicants will be entered into the "hat" for the first drawing. Applicants will be given their desired day, if it is available. Otherwise, their 2nd choice day will be used.
- 2) Applicants requesting more than 1 day of Lunch Bunch will be put back into the "hat" for the "2nd day pick". Names drawn will be given a 2nd day slot if available in the same manner as above.

EXTENDED LEARNING PROGRAM DESCRIPTION AND APPLICATION
2011-2012

EXTENDED LEARNING offers students in our Older Classes an opportunity to participate in a topic investigation or project. The project-based “inquiry” curriculum model focuses on topics in art, literature, nature, and science. The daily schedule is as follows:

- Arrival – 11:15 A.M.
- Lunch – 11:15-12:00 Noon
- Rest/quiet time – 12:15-1:00 P.M.
- Outdoor time – 1:00-1:20 P.M.
- Project time – 1:30-2:30 P.M.
- Dismissal – 2:30 P.M.

TIME & COST

Students go directly to Lunch Bunch at the end of the regular school session at 11:15 and stay until 2:30. The cost is \$27 per day.

- Extended Learning slots are purchased on an annual basis. Payments are due quarterly and are included on tuition payment vouchers for the year. A deposit equal to 1 month’s tuition (\$108 for 1 day/week and \$216 for 2 days/week) is due with the application. This deposit will secure your child’s spot for the 2011-2012 school year.
- If a parent chooses to withdraw his/her child from the program, the parent is still responsible for the remaining yearly payment (until the school is able to fill the slot).
